“C.R.O.S.S.P.O.I.N.T.E. (Pt. 2)”

What Makes C.R.O.S.S.P.O.I.N.T.E. Church Distinct?

1. C – Casual, contemporary, come as you are environment (Rev. 22:17)
2. R – Relevant communication (Hab.2:2)
3. O – Optimistic, faith-based lifestyle (Prov. 3:5-6)
4. S – Supportive, loving relationships [Life Groups] (Acts 2:42-47)
5. S – Spiritual gift-based, volunteer service (Eph. 4:11-13)
6. P – Purpose-Driven
 - **Matt. 22:36-40; 28:19-20:** “Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?’ ³⁷Jesus replied: ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. ³⁸This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. ⁴⁰All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

The CrossPointe Code – T3 = C3

Touching God through demonstrating love to Him, to one another & to the unbelieving lost (**worship**).
Transforming lives through connecting with one another & growing together in unity, maturity & Christ-likeness (**fellowship & discipleship**).

Taking risks through reaching out relationally to serve others and to share Jesus Christ (**ministry & evangelism**).

7. O – Outside-the-box thinking
 - **Prov. 14:15:** “A simple man believes anything, but a prudent man gives thought to his steps.”
8. I – Inerrancy of Scripture
 - **2 Tim. 3:16-17:** “All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”
9. N – Non-threatening “missional” mindset
 - **Matt. 4:19-20:** “‘Come, follow me,’ Jesus said, ‘and I will make you fishers of men.’” ²⁰At once they left their nets and followed him.”
10. T – Team-based, servant leadership
 - **Matt. 20:25a, 26b-28:** “Jesus called them together and said, ‘whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, ²⁷and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— ²⁸just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.’”
11. E – Enthusiastic generosity
 - **2 Cor. 9:6-7:** “Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”
